

Neurodevelopmental scores are significantly different in the four NICI categories, especially when comparing Controls (0 category) and neonates that experienced the highest number of invasive

procedures (III category). Note that  $\bf 0$  indicates no painful events during the early post-natal period or <5 skin breaks (i.e. heel lances, central line insertion, intramuscular injection);  $\bf I$ , >5 skin breaks or neonatal endotracheal intubation;  $\bf II$ , >5 skin breaks and neonatal endotracheal intubation;  $\bf III$ , surgical interventions (i.e. patent ductus arteriosus ligation, surgical necrotizing enterocolitis). \* indicates  $\bf P$ =.01.
