

Table S1. Definitions of ecological terminologies used.

	Definition
<i>Density</i>	Measure of the number of organisms in a defined area.
<i>Biomass</i>	The total weight of organisms in a given area or volume.
<i>Species diversity</i>	The number of different species that are represented in a given community. Species diversity consists of two components: species richness and species evenness. <i>Species richness</i> is a simple count of species, whereas <i>species evenness</i> quantifies how equally the individuals in a community are distributed across species.
<i>Target species</i>	Species primarily sought by the fishermen in a particular fishery.
<i>Non-target species</i>	Species that are not specifically targeted by a particular fishery but that may be incidentally captured as part of the targeted catch.
