- 1. Permanent loss of intelligence of your child, average 7 IQ points
- 2. Three times greater risk of schizophrenia caused by fetal and childhood exposure
- 3. Greater risk of Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Syndrome
- 4. Placenta previa (The placenta covers the cervix, leading to dangerous bleeding.)
- 5. Placental abruption (The placenta separates prematurely, endangering both mother and baby.)
- 6. Thyroid dysfunction
- 7. Ectopic pregnancy
- 8. Premature rupture of membranes (The sac the baby lives in is punctured, risking delivery before the lungs are mature.)

- 10. Intrauterine growth restriction caused by starving the growing fetus of oxygen, average loss of weight at birth at least ½ pound
- 11. 2-3 times greater risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) which is the death of a baby with no cause after birth
- 12. Asthma after birth
- 13. Greater risk of congenital heart defects
- 14. Greater risk of alien abduction immediately after birth
